### Art in the Garden Gala

The annual Art in the Garden Gala is scheduled for Thursday, April 24, 2014, at the home of Monica and D T Froedge,601 S. Green St., Glasgow, from 6:00 to 8:00 pm.. Food for the event will be catered by Micqueal's Bistro and drinks will be provided by the Guild under the direction of Sally Puntel. Music for the event will be provided by the Barren County String ensemble. Each artist is allowed to display 6 pieces. Jewelry and craft artists are allowed to use their own discretion as to their display. Twenty percent of sales will go to the Guild. Tickets (\$15) will be printed by Betty Brogan and will be for sale at 212 on the Main, by guild members, and at the door. At the April 10<sup>th</sup> membership meeting, members are encouraged to take a number of tickets to sale in order for the guild to have an idea of how many persons will be attending. Each artist must prepare a written description of each painting to be sold. This must have the name of the painting, medium, price and name of the artist. This information absolutely must be turned in at 212 on the Main (attention Betty Brogan) by or before Thur., April 17<sup>th</sup>. Pieces are to be delivered to the Froedge home from 9:00 am to noon on April 24<sup>th</sup>. Paulette Peil, Patty Hughes, and Mica Guilfoil have agreed to set up the pieces. Ledean Hamilton is in charge of soliciting corporate sponsors. Carolyn Wyatt's husband, Danny, has agreed to contact the radio stations and Betty Brogan has agreed to contact various publications to advertise the Gala. Carolyn Wyatt, Sandy Johnson and Tish Sabens will prepare door prizes. At the April 10<sup>th</sup> meeting, we will need some members to volunteer to deliver chairs to the Froedge's and volunteers to help clean up after the event.

**Up for discussion-** Currently members pay \$15 for a ticket for the Gala and 20% commission. It has been proposed that the \$15 ticket price be deducted from the commission if a member sells a piece at the gala. This would be a win-win for the artist as the Gallery gives up its part of the \$15 commission. We will discuss this at our meeting.
