Coming Soon: 212 on the MAIN, Fine Arts & Gifts



212 on the MAIN is scheduled to open September 27, 2013. The hours will be 10-4 Wednesday– Friday and 9-1 on Saturday. We plan to keep these hours through Christmas. We will cut back on our hours after the first of the year. Since our gallery will be operated by us we are asking everyone hanging art to work a minimum of one shift per month. We will have a calendar for you to select your time when you bring your art on the 19th-21st or email agb@artsguildofthebarrens.org to schedule your time in advance.

Options for Displaying

Artist can choose to display their work two different ways. We will have booth spaces available for rent and had a random drawing to choose spots. There are still a few spaces available. We will repeat this process at the quarterly changing of the art in January. The cost will be \$25 with no commission charged. If you just want to hang a few pieces there will be a 25% commission for each piece. Monthly rental fee will be due when you bring your art on September 19th-21st. You can pay for all three months at one time or you can choose to pay the first of each month. Check for monthly sales will be available for pick up at the gallery the first of each month.

“THE EARTH WITHOUT ART IS JUST EH” --Winston Churchill.




How to Tag Your Art

In order to have items listed at *212 on the Main* you will need to have each item tagged with its own unique inventory number. You may choose your own vendor number or we can assign you one. Your vendor number needs to be two letters. These letters could be two letters that are your business name or your own initials. Each item will be labeled with your vendor identification followed by a unique code. You may use up to 4 digits after your vendor number. You will receive an email with a spread sheet to list your items. If you have excel please type your items in and send it to agb@artsguildofthebarrens.org prior to the 19th. If you do not have the ability to do this you can print out the sheet and bring it with you on the 19th. We will have the inventory list available for you on the 19th if needed. I will enter these into the computer and print out a sheet for you to check your inventory. Tags will be available on the 19th.
